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SCHOOL BASED PROGRAMS

DEKALB ALTERNATIVE SCHOOL

PROFESSIONAL READINESS EXPERIENCE PROGRAM (P.R.E.P) / PROJECT ACCELERATE

We focused on Self Care and ensuring that the girls kept their mental space and physical spaces clean and productive. We were also able to introduce the girls to Delta Zeta Psi sorority who will be helping us during our sessions.

Our first session with G.L.O.W. focused on introducing ourselves and creating a safe space. For the activities, the girls created period packs to keep in their backpacks while also learning the anatomy and reasons behind periods. We also discussed staying safe in their bedrooms and media literacy when scrolling through apps.



SERVICE SATURDAYS

Service Saturday kicked off with an introduction session showing the girls easy meals they could make to potentially serve their community. This month focused on selfcare so the women of Delta Zeta Psi gifted the girls totes packed with items needed for everyday upkeep.
